THIS Memorandum of Understanding is made on this 6th day of May, 2025 at Asansol Girls' College between

Asansol Mines Board of Health, Asansol, India located at Court Compound, Katchary Road, Asansol, West Bengal, Pin – 713304

AND

ASANSOL GIRLS' COLLEGE located at ASANSOL, India and having its campus at Dr. Anjali Roy Sarani, ASANSOL – 713304, India (hereinafter called 'AGC' which expression shall unless repugnant to the context includes its successors and assigns, of the second part);

However, for any reference on execution of this agreement on behalf of the Asansol Mines Board of Health, a constituent laboratory under _____ having its office at Katchary Road, Asansol, West Bengal, Pin – 713304 (hereinafter called AMBH) may be referred in the first instance.

1. PREAMBLE 1.1 AMBH has been a pioneer in providing healthcare services to the people in accordance with providing other services, inclusive of sanitation, water purification, medical facilities, and vaccination for the people of Asansol Raniganj zone since 1915.
- 1.2 AGC is a Government sponsored UG college established in 1950 and presently is one of the leading educational institutions of Asansol with a student strength of nearly 2700 in each academic session. It is affiliated to the Kazi Nazrul University and has been re-accredited a 3rd cycle with B++ by NAAC in 2024. At present there are 20 UG departments and 1 post-graduate department with professional course like BCA to meet the requirements of the changing times.


To promote great learning opportunity for the students who would be able to gain first-hand knowledge in the applicative fields of environment and to extend the knowledge base and infrastructure of AMBH as a part of the Skill Initiative, the two institutions, i.e. AMBH and ASANSOL GIRLS' COLLEGE agree to the following broad terms of co-operation.

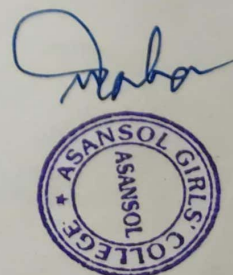
NOW IT IS HEREBY AGREED AND DECLARED BY AND BETWEEN THE INSTITUTIONS HERE TO AS FOLLOWS:

- 2.0 SCOPE OF MoU 2.1 Both the Institutions will support each other's endeavors in delivery of industry-ready skilled youth force through the following though not limited to:

- Hands-on skill promotion to – 100 no. of students per year on "Water Quality Assessment"
- Jointly organize skill development programmes and events such as seminars, workshop, conferences.
- Exchange of information for conduction of need-based skill development programmes in response to students' requirements.

Allowing the partaking students of AGC to engage in outdoor activities like water sample collection from various sites.

Reciprocation of expert view and suggestions between both the institutions as per requisites.

. Any other matter(s) as agreed which are not covered.

- 2.2 Both Institutions acknowledge and understand that all financial arrangements would be borne by the students (training fee Rs.300/- student) and deposited by the college to AMBH to prior to each training program on Water Quality assessment.
- 2.3 No Institution shall have the right to use the name or logo of another Institution without the prior approval of that institution in writing.
- 2.4 The terms of this MoU may be modified/amended at any time, subject to mutual written agreement. Such modifications/changes shall be effective from the date on which both the institutions execute them in writing.

3.0 **RESPONSIBILITIES OF BOTH THE INSTITUTIONS**

- 3.1 Both Institutions mutually agree to promote skill promotion and skill development programmes on "Water Quality Assessment" and depute students as per requirements (-100 no/year) with mutual-consent.
- 3.2 AMBH shall conduct the skill development programmes at AMBH premises and shall make available the necessary infrastructure and facilities for accomplishing the above laid down objectives.
- 3.3 AGC shall depute batches of UG students for undergoing training at AMBH at mutually identified time periods throughout the year.
- 3.4 AGC shall also pay the training fees to AMBH in a consolidated manner prior to the commencement of each training programme.
- 3.5 AGC shall also ensure requisite discipline within the deputed student batches and financially compensate for any damage to machine and property, if any, incurred during the training.

4.0 **VALIDITY**

This MoU shall be in full force and effect from the date of signature hereof for a period of 3 years. Either organization may terminate this MoU at any time by giving six months' notice in writing to the other. In the event of termination, program under way shall be allowed to be completed according to the terms that have been agreed upon.

5.0 **ARBITRATION AND JURISDICTION**

In the event of any dispute or differences between the institutions hereto, such disputes or differences shall be resolved amicably by mutual consultation or through the good offices of empowered agencies of the Government of India.
